Cassey is a 24 year old who was injured in March 2014 when she suffered an accident that caused her to break her spinal cord, lose consciousness, and have a traumatic brain injury. She was found to have a c5-6 break in her spinal cord that caused her to be a quadriplegic. Cassey received treatment at Strong Hospital as well as extensive physical therapy and occupational therapy treatments during her 7 month stay at Monroe Community Hospital Rehabilitation

wing. After returning to her community in December 2014, Cassey has been successfully living independently with the assistance of Hickok Service Coordination. As a young woman, she leads a socially full lifestyle where she is active in the WNY Wreckers, a wheelchair rugby team in the Rochester area. Cassey has regained the ability to walk and also acquired her own vehicle, allowing her to drive herself to her many activities. Cassey's sheer determination, focus and positive attitude serves as an inspiration for all in her situation.



Clifford was referred to the Hickok Center for Vocational Services. Cliff worked for Kodak in shipping and receiving for ten years prior to a stroke. Unfortunately, he was unable to return to his previous line of work. After several applications and interviews, Cliff could not find a position that excited and challenged

him. The decision was made to look at returning to college. Hickok Vocational Services assisted Cliff in the enrollment and application process, as well as financial planning. He began his journey to Teacher's Assistant in September, 2016. Cliff has volunteered his time with kids for years. He brings this love of youth with him while pursuing his goal.
